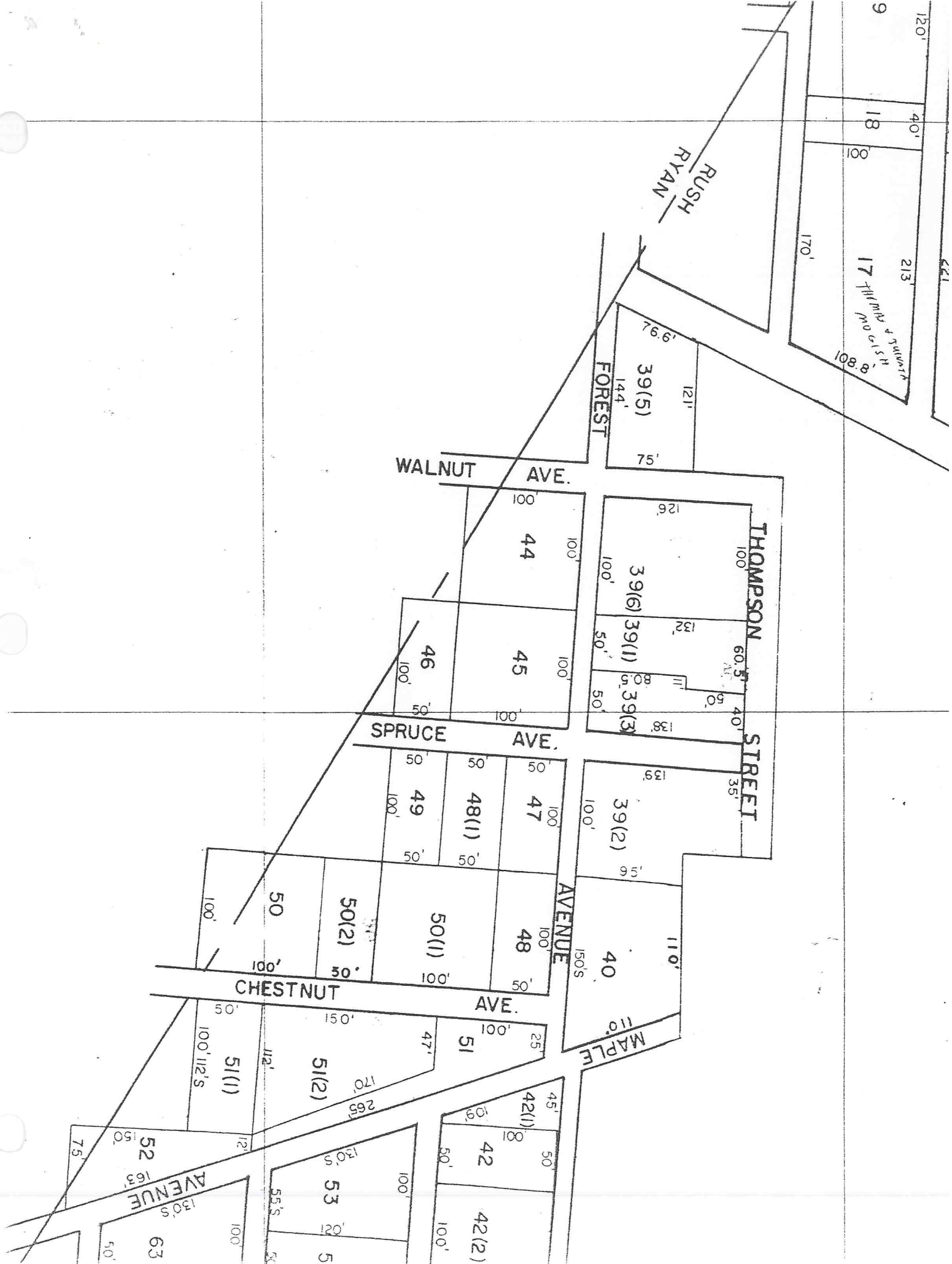

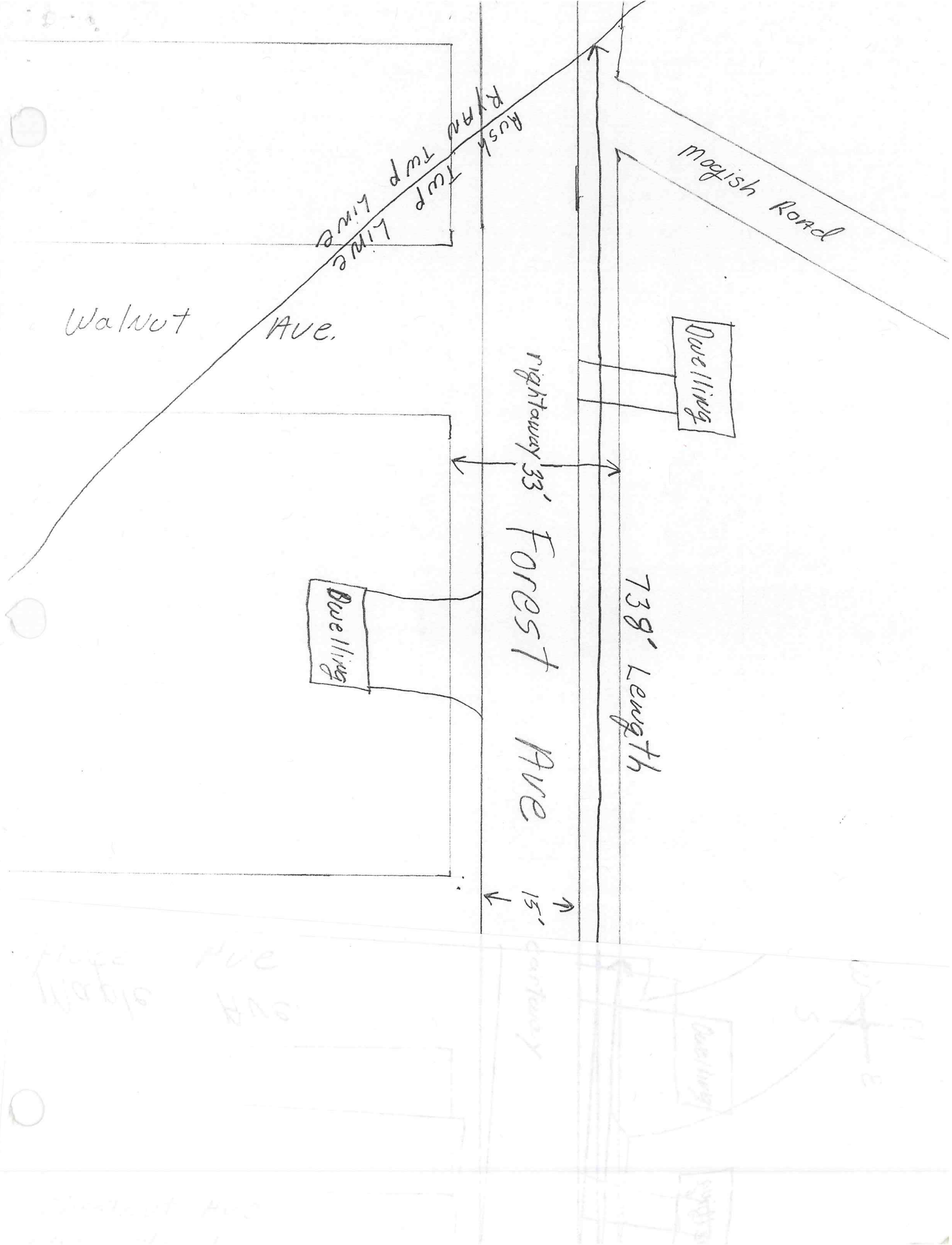

DESCRIPTION OF FOREST AVENUE

**BEGINNING** on the East side of Maple Avenue in Rush Township and extending for a width of thirty-three (33') feet in a westwardly direction seven hundred and thirty-eight (738') feet to the Rush/Ryan Township boundary lines as more fully set forth in maps attached hereto and forming part of Exhibit "A".
