ORDINANCE NO. 139

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING PARKING REGULATIONS ALONG GOLF ROAD, VILLAGE OF BARNESVILLE.

SECTION 1. Golf Road in the Village of Barnesville extends westwardly from S.R. 1015 a distance of two thousand two hundred (2,200') feet, more or less, and is twenty (20') feet in width.

SECTION 2. Because of the number of homes situate along both sides of the road, the topographic limitations and the railroad along the northern shoulder, and the narrow cartway for the traveling public, it is necessary to prohibit parking thereon for the length of one thousand four hundred (1,400') feet, more or less.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED and ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Rush Township, Schuylkill County, that "No Parking" will be permitted along Golf Road for a distance of one thousand four hundred (1,400') feet westwardly from the intersection with S.R. 1015 at any point within the Township's right-of-way.

ENACTED and ORDAINED into an Ordinance this 7th day of December, 1999.
