## RUSH TOWNSHIP, SCHUYLKILL COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA ORDINANCE NO. $\underline{160}$

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 154, AND INCREASING THE EMERGENCY AND MUNICIPAL SERVICE TAX FROM THIRTY (\$30) TO FIFTY-TWO (\$52) DOLLARS

WHEREAS Rush Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania adopted Ordinance No. 154 imposing an emergency and municipal services tax on all those persons employed or otherwise engaged in an income producing occupation in Rush Township on January 18, 2004; and

WHEREAS, Enabling legislation authorizing the imposition of such tax authorizes a rate of tax of fifty-two (\$52) dollars a year;

NOW THEREFORE be it ordained by the Rush Township Board of Supervisors this <u>20th</u> day of <u>December</u>, 2005 as follows:

- 1. That Ordinance No. 154, Section 3a., shall be amended as follows:
  - i. The phrase, "A tax is levied at the rate of thirty (\$30) dollars per year for any of the following purposes:" shall be deleted and the following phrase shall be substituted. "A tax is levied at the rate of fifty-two (\$52) dollars per year for any of the following purposes:"
- 2. All of the rest, remainder and balance of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect as originally written.
- 3. If any part, phrase, or section of this Amendment to the Ordinance is ruled unenforceable by any Court of competent jurisdiction then only that part or phrase shall be unenforceable and the balance of this Amendment shall remain enforceable.
- 4. This Ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days after the date of its adoption, but in any event, no earlier than January 1, 2006.
