

Ordinance No. 169

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Rush, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania.

Section 1. Definitions

- (a) As used in this ordinance the following terms shall have the meanings indicated, unless a different meaning clearly appears from the context.
- (b) Handicapped person: an individual possessing or severely disabled veteran registration plate or placard.
- (c) Handicapped Parking Sign: A sign issued by the Rush Township, for one (1) vehicle space and erected at a designated and agreed upon area for access for a handicapped person.
- (d) Issuing Authority: A Rush Township Zoning Office.
- (e) Owner: Actual owner, agent or custodian of property wherein a sign will be erected.

Section 2. Reserved parking for individuals that qualify for handicapped parking in Rush Township under the following conditions:

- (a) Only those that are approved by state to have handicapped license plates.
- (b) That parking is available on street individual resides.
- (c) That parking spot to be issued does not interfere with local businesses operation.
- (d) That parking spot follows all state parking rules.(with-in stop signs, not near fire hydrant, ect)
- (e) The reserved handicapped space is for use by the registered handicapped owner.
- (f) The Township will paint lines and install numbered handicapped sign.

Section 3. The provisions of this ordinance for reserved handicapped parking shall be renewed on a yearly basis and shall be subject to fees levied by Rush Township for a numbered parking space.

- (a) The application fee for permanent handicapped parking space is seventy (\$70.00) dollars.
- (b) The application for renewal for handicapped parking space is fifteen (\$15.00) dollars.
- (c) All fees for handicapped parking space are non-refundable.

Section 4. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be removed from the use of handicapped parking positions by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Rush, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania.

- (a) Any person owning a vehicle parked in a handicapped parking designated area without a

handicapped plate or placard and qualifying under this ordinance will be subject to citation.

- (b) The fine or penalty for violation here and before shall be thirty (\$30.00) dollars, if paid within five (5) days of violation, and if paid after lapse of five (5) days of violation sixty (\$60.00) dollars.


Section 5. Should any part of this ordinance be held invalid, by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining section shall be severable and shall continue to be in force and effect.

Section 6. All ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.


Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after adoption.
