A RESOLUTION RENAMING DOUGLAS STREET IN THE VILLAGE OF STILL CREEK, RUSH TOWNSHIP, TO WESNER STREET IN HONOR OF DECEASED VETERAN, ALBERT R. WESNER, WHO DIED IN SERVICE OF HIS COUNTRY ON JULY 7, 1944.

WHEREAS, there have been a number of residents of Rush Township that have lost their lives serving in the Armed Services of the United States protecting the citizens and land of our Country; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Rush Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, recognizes that those who have made the supreme sacrifice should be memorialized and remembered, especially by those in their community; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Rush Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, has the authority under the Second Class Township Code to name the streets and roads of the Township; and

WHEREAS, it is proper and fitting that those who have given their lives and made the supreme sacrifice while defending our country and preserving peace in the world be remembered by the designation of certain public streets and roads by using the names of the deceased veterans in order to continually bring to the public mind the sacrifice of these individuals;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 7th day of December, 1999, by the Board of Supervisors of Rush Township that Douglas Street in the Village of Still Creek extending westwardly from S.R. 309 a distance of two hundred sixty-five (265') feet to the intersection with Madison Street, and being thirty-three and one-half (33 ½') foot in width, is hereby renamed as Wesner Street.
