

RESOLUTION NO. 99-5

WHEREAS, pursuant to the enactment of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, certain political subdivisions, including Rush Township, Schuylkill County, are authorized to levy, assess, and collect local taxes and/or charges, including those herein specified; and

WHEREAS, Rush Township, Schuylkill County, by Resolution/Ordinance has levied, assessed, and provided for the collection of those taxes and/or charges herein specified; and

WHEREAS, the enactments of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the Resolutions/Ordinances of Rush Township, Schuylkill County, specify that any such political subdivision may provide for the creation of such bureaus or the appointment and compensation of such officers, clerks, collectors, and other assistants and employees as may be deemed necessary for the assessment and collection of the herein specified taxes and/or charges and the collection of delinquent taxes and/or charges imposed under the authority of said enactments;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Rush Township, Schuylkill County, hereby appoints **BERKHEIMER ASSOCIATES** as its **Delinquent** Per Capita Tax officer.
