**RESOLUTION NO. 2000-2**

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTIONS 89-11, 91-8, AND 95-8, WHICH CONTINUE AND AMEND THE RUSH TOWNSHIP POLICE PENSION PLAN FOR FULL-TIME POLICE EMPLOYEES.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Rush Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, hereby amends its Police Pension Plan upon increasing its police department from two to three full-time officers and, thus, for purposes of compliance with Act 600.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Resolutions 89-11, 91-8, and 95-8 be and are hereby amended to provide as follows:

**Section 1.** The age and service requirements are hereby set at a total of 25 years of police service with the Township and age 55.

**Section 2.** Upon retirement, a member shall be entitled to a monthly pension of 50 percent of his monthly average salary during the last 36 months of employment.

**Section 3.** Each member shall contribute monthly 5 percent of total compensation, including salary, court pay, holiday pay, and any other remunerations. Member contributions may be reduced or eliminated on an annual basis by resolution, provided that current actuarial study indicates that the condition of the fund is such that member contributions may be reduced or eliminated, and contributions by the Township are not required to keep the fund actuarially sound.
