

RESOLUTION 05-12

WHEREAS, Rush Township ("applicant") desires to undertake the following project

[*project title*] Quakake Playground Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the applicant desires to apply to the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources ("Department") for a grant for the purpose of carrying out this project; and

WHEREAS, the application package includes a document entitled "Terms and Conditions of Grant" and a document entitled "Signature Page for Grant Application and Grant Agreement"; and

- 3. If the applicant is awarded a grant, the "Signature Page for Grant Application and Grant Agreement," signed by the above official, will become the applicant/grantee's executed signature page for the Grant Agreement, and the applicant/grantee will be bound by the Grant Agreement.
- 4. Any amendment to the Grant Agreement may be signed on behalf of the grantee by the official who, at the time of signing of the amendment, has the title specified in paragraph 1 and the grantee will be bound by the amendment.

The project would entail continued improvements to the stormwater collection system. Funds previously obtained through a CDBG allotment provided the Township the ability to construct a new stormwater collection system to divert mountain stormwater runoff away from residential properties and road intersections/gutters.

The Township intends to seek FY'06 CDBG funds in order to extend stormwater collection lines on Vernon Miller Street in Grier City

What specific problems would be solved if this project is funded? (i.e.: detail how many and which homes get flooded for a storm water project; why new waterlines are needed; what problems persons with disabilities have in attending meetings)

Diversion of the stormwater runoff west at T477 will reduce flooding of intersections, driveways and properties along SR1017 and T477.

What is the status of the project? (i.e., right of way to be acquired, permits needed, engineering and design work to be done; applications to be filed for other funding.)

The Grier City Drainage Project was completed in July 1998. The proposed extension is in the preliminary stages of design. The final design will be authorized upon approval of FY'06 funding request.
