RESOLUTION NO. 2005-03

A RESOLUTION PROHIBITING SMOKING IN PUBLIC BUILDINGS OWNED AND OPERATED BY RUSH TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, The Surgeon General of the United States and the United States Department of Health have deemed smoking tobacco products and other similar substances to be hazardous to the health of the citizens and the residents of the United States; and;

WHEREAS, health concerns have been raised by those agencies with respect to the existence of so-called second hand smoke; and,

WHEREAS, smoke from tobacco and similar products make create problems in the ventilation system and stain and the odors therefrom permeate the furniture and walls;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors, this 18th day of January, 2005, as follows:

1. All public buildings owned and operated by Rush Township, Schuylkill County, including meeting rooms, offices, garages and the like are hereby declared no smoking areas and smoking of all tobacco and any other product is hereby prohibited;


2. All smoking whether by cigarette, pipe, cigar or other device of tobacco or other products is hereby prohibited and the Supervisors are hereby authorized to post notices to that effect in any township building, office or area in which they deem it appropriate;

3. Smoking in the hallways and doorways of the said public building and in the exterior areas near any doorways is likewise prohibited.




