**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RUSH,
COUNTY OF SCHUYLKILL, PENNSYLVANIA**

**APPROVING THE TRANSFER OF RESTAURANT LIQUOR
LICENSE NO. R-17922 INTO RUSH TOWNSHIP**

WHEREAS, Section 461 of the Pennsylvania Liquor Code authorizes the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board to approve the transfer of restaurant liquor licenses across municipal boundaries within the same county; and

WHEREAS, municipalities receiving a new license must issue a resolution approving the intermunicipal transfer of the liquor license from outside the receiving township to within its borders prior to submission of an application for such transfer to the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; and

WHEREAS, the Liquor Code stipulates that, prior to adoption of a resolution by the receiving municipality, at least one hearing be held for the purpose of permitting interested parties to state their concerns regarding the transfer of liquor license into the receiving municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Reese Bowling Centers, Inc., d/b/a/ Sparetime Lanes, has properly requested the approval of the Board of Supervisors of Rush Township for the proposed transfer of Pennsylvania Restaurant Liquor License No. R-17922, held by Monberger, Inc., t/a Sands Restaurant, of 201-203 E. Centre Street, Shenandoah, Pennsylvania, 17976-2614, to Reese Bowling Centers, Inc., d/b/a Sparetime Lanes, at 17 Tide Road, Rush Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Rush Township has held a public hearing on February 16, 2012, and had previously given public notice thereof on February 2 and February 9, 2012, to receive comments on the proposed liquor license transfer and, after consideration of the issues, finds that the transfer of Restaurant Liquor License No. 17922 into Rush Township to Reese Bowling Centers, Inc. would not be detrimental to the health, welfare, peace or morals of Rush Township or its residents; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Rush Township approves, by adoption of and for the reasons stated in this Resolution, the proposed transfer of Restaurant Liquor License No. R-17922 into Rush Township; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the transfer of liquor license contemplated hereby is subject to approval by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board.
