

ORDINANCE NO. 1

An Ordinance to open a road wholly within Rush Township, Schuylkill County.

Whereas, in the judgment of the supervisors they have decided in the interest of public convenience, to open by ordinance, a section of road herein described, now therefore

Be it Ordained and Enacted by the Supervisors of Rush Township, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same,

Section 1. That in the judgment of the Supervisors, the following described roads situate in Hometown in Rush Township aforesaid be and the same are opened:

- a. A fifty (50) feet wide street known as Maple Street beginning at the intersection of said street and old highway running from Tamaqua to Hazleton and extending North 39 Degrees 41 minutes East a distance of three hundred thirteen (313) feet to Meadow Avenue; and continuing by the same course beyond Meadow Avenue a distance of one hundred fifty (150) feet;
- b. A fifty (50) feet wide street known as Meadow Avenue, beginning at Maple Street and extending a distance of Six Hundred (600) feet to Oak Lane Street;
- c. A fifty (50) feet wide Street known as Oak Lane Lane, beginning at the intersection of said Street with the old highway running from Tamaqua to Hazleton and extending a distance of four hundred fifteen (415) feet to Meadow Avenue.
- d. A fifty (50) feet wide strip of land beginning at the intersection of Oak Lane and Meadow Avenues and extending a distance of one hundred ninety (190) feet to the new state highway running from Tamaqua to Hazleton. (W. J. H. H. W. 17. H. S. G. G. H. H. 47-2)

Section 2. That the Township Solicitor is authorized and directed

to file a certified copy of the Ordinance in the office of the Court of Quarter Sessions together with the names of the owner of property affected and a draft and survey of the road.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
