

ORDINANCE No. 11

An Ordinance, lay-out, adopting, naming and taking over two (2) streets or roads; one in the Hometown Section and one in the Quakake Section of Rush Township; fixing the lengths, widths and termini thereof and ordaining the same to be Township Roads.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Rush Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the provisions of the Act of 1947, P.L. 1481, Section 15 &c. (53 P.S. 66101) as amended, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

SECTION I: The following streets and roads are hereby laid-out, opened, adopted, taken-over, ordained, and named as follows:

1. CHESTNUT STREET in the Hometown Section of Rush Township from its intersection with Ridge Street, East to its intersection with Tamaqua Street, being a street thirty-three (33') feet in width and seven hundred twenty-five (725') feet in length.
2. THIRD STREET in the Quakake Section of Rush Township from its intersection with Walnut Street, East to its intersection with Centre Street, being a street thirty-three (33') feet in width and five hundred four (504') feet in length.

SECTION II: The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable and if any of its provisions, or any part of any provision shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this ordinance would have been adopted if such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid provision had not been included herein.

SECTION III: All Ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with any of the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
