

ORDINANCE NO. 115

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING RUSH TOWNSHIP TO ERECT STOP SIGNS AND OTHER TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNALS UPON TOWNSHIP ROADS FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP TO DESIGNATE THE LOCATION OF SUCH STOP SIGNS AND TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNALS BY RESOLUTION AND ESTABLISHING VIOLATIONS THEREOF AS A SUMMARY OFFENSE INCORPORATING THE PENALTIES SET FORTH IN THE PENNSYLVANIA VEHICLE CODE

WHEREAS, The Rush Township Board of Supervisors has been advised that the traffic in Rush Township requires greater control in order to enhance the safety and welfare of the public;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this 13 day of July , 1995, as follows:

1. Rush Township is hereby authorized to erect traffic control signals, including stop signs or traffic lights on Township roads that intersect with state maintained highways, roads, routs and the like; that the location and authorization for the placement of the signs and other traffic control signals may be established by a resolution of the Township Board of Supervisors, or temporarily at the direction of the police chief of the Township;
2. That such stop signs and traffic control signals my be removed by resolutions of the Board of Supervisors;
3. Stop signs and other traffic signals shall have their usual and normal meaning as defined by the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code;
4. Violation of this Ordinance shall be a summary offense punishable by the fines and other penalties for similar violations set forth in the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code entitled 75 Pa.S.C. 101 et seq. are hereby incorporated by reference.
5. This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with the Second Class Township Code five (5) days after adoption.
