ORDINANCE NO. 14

An Ordinance laying-out, adopting, naming and taking over certain streets and roads in the Hometown section of Rush Township; fixing the lengths, widths and termini thereof and ordaining the same to be Township Roads.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Rush Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the provisions of the Act of 1947, P. L. 1481, Sec. 15 &c., (53 PS 66101) as amended, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

Section I: The following street or road is hereby laid out, opened, adopted, taken over, ordained and named as follows:

 Ryan Avenue from its intersection with Hunter Street extending westwardly a distance of nine hundred eightyseven (987') feet, being a street fifty (50') feet in width and nine hundred eighty-seven (987') feet in length.

Section II: The provisions of this ordinance shall be severable, and if any of its provisions, or any part of any provision shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this ordinance would have been adopted if such unconstitutional, ellegal or invalid provision had not been included herein.

Section III: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with any of the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
