

ORDINANCE NO. 19

AN ORDINANCE laying-out, adopting, naming and taking over certain streets and roads in the Hometown Section and the Still Creek Section of Rush Township; fixing the lengths, widths and termini thereof, and ordaining the same to be Township Roads.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Rush Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the provisions of the Act of 1947, P.L. 1481, Section 15 &c. (53-PS-66-101) as amended, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

SECTION I: The following streets or roads are hereby laid out, opened, adopted, taken over, ordained and named as follows:

1. Pine Avenue, from its intersection with State Highway Route No. 309 extending eastwardly a distance of two hundred fifty (250') feet to its intersection with Cumberland Avenue, being a street thirty three (33') feet in width and two hundred fifty (250') feet in length.
2. Douglas Street, from its intersection with U.S. Highway Route #309 extending westwardly two hundred sixty five (265') feet to its intersection with Madison Street, being a street thirty three and one-half (33 1/2') feet in width and two hundred sixty five (265') feet in length.
3. Madison Street, from its intersection with Highway Route #53040 extending northwardly a distance of two hundred seventy five (275') feet in length.

SECTION II: The provisions of this ordinance shall be severable, and if any of its provisions, or any part of any provision shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

It is hereby declared to the legislative intent that this ordinance would have been adopted if such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid provision had not been included herein.

SECTION III: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with any of the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
