ORDINANCE NO. 2

An Ordinance to open a road wholly within Rush Township, Schuylkill County.

Whereas, in the judgment of the supervisors they have decided in the interest of public convenience, to open by ordinance, a section of road herein described, now therefore

Be it Ordained and Enacted by the Supervisors of Rush Town-ship, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same,

Section 1. That in the judgment of the Supervisors, the following described road situate in Hometown in Rush Township aforesaid be and the same is opened:

A thirty-three (33) feet wide street, known as Hunter Street, beginning on the South side of Mahanoy Avenue and extending southwardly a distance of eight hundred fifty (850) feet to the north side of Wayne Avenue.

Section 2. That the Township Solicitor is authorized and directed to file a certified copy of the Ordinance in the office of the Court of Quarter Sessions together with the names of the owner of property affected and a draft and survey of the road.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
