

ORDINANCE NO. 25

AN ORDINANCE, laying-out, adopting, naming and taking over two (2) streets or roads; one in the Grier City Section and the other in the Barnesville Section of Rush Township; fixing the lengths, widths and termini thereof and ordaining the same to be Township Roads.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Rush Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the provisions of The Second Class Township Code, Article XI, Sections 1,101 et seq., and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

SECTION I. The following streets and roads are hereby laid out, opened, adopted, taken over, ordained as follows:

1. A road in the Grier City Section of Rush Township leading northwardly from its intersection with Township Road No. 477 a distance of one hundred eighty five (185') feet; thence eastwardly a distance of eight hundred fifty eight (858') feet; thence southwardly a distance of one hundred eighty five (185') feet to its intersection with Township Road No. 477, it being thirty three (33') feet in width.

2. A road in the Barnesville Section of Rush Township, leading eastwardly from Township Road No. 862 a distance of six hundred (600') feet, it being thirty three (33') feet in width.

SECTION II. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable and if any of its provisions, or any part of any provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this ordinance would have been adopted if such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid provision had not been included herein.

SECTION III. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
