

ORDINANCE NO. 26

AN ORDINANCE laying out, adopting and taking over certain streets or roads; one in the Grier City Section; one in the Guenthers Section; and one in the Hometown Section of Rush Township; fixing the lengths, widths and termini thereof and ordaining the same to be Township Roads.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF RUSH TOWNSHIP, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the provisions of the Second Class Township Code, Article XI, Section 66101 et seq., and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

SECTION I: The following streets and roads are hereby laid out, opened, adopted, taken over and ordained as follows:

1. A road in the Grier City Section of Rush Township, being thirty three (33') feet in width, leading Westwardly from Legislative Route 53044 a distance of seven hundred sixty five (765') feet.
2. A road in the Guenther's Section of Rush Township, known as McKnight Street, being forty (40') feet in width and leading Eastwardly from Highway Route No. 309, a distance of one hundred twenty (120') feet.
3. A road in the Hometown Section of Rush Township, known as Susquehanna Road, being fifty (50') feet in width and leading Southwardly from its intersection with Laurelwood Street a distance of one hundred seventy five and thirty three one-hundredths (175.33') feet.

SECTION II: The provisions of this ordinance shall be severable, and if any of it's provisions, or any part of any provision shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this ordinance would have been

adopted if such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid provision had not been included herein.

SECTION III: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with any of the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
