

ORDINANCE NO. 27

AN ORDINANCE regulating and restricting outdoor fires within Rush Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, and prescribing penalties for the violation thereof.

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF RUSH TOWNSHIP, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION I. No person or persons, firm or corporation, shall set or maintain, or cause to be set or maintained any fire upon any of the streets, sidewalks, alleys or public grounds in the Township of Rush, or burn or cause to be burned thereon any paper, boxes, rubbish, leaves, or other material or substance of any kind.

SECTION II. Out-of-doors fires shall be permitted upon private property in Rush Township, provided that the following regulations and restrictions are strictly adhered to: Every such out-of-door fire shall be built in, and confined to a non-cumbustible container, covered with a screen of suitable mesh, or other suitable non-combustible cover. No such fire shall be closer than TEN (10) FEET from any building. No such fire shall be allowed to burn upon any day, except between the hours of 8:00 o'clock A.M. and sundown during Daylight Saving Time; and 8:00 o'clock A.M. and 7:30 P.M. during Standard Time.

SECTION III: Any person who shall violate or fail to conform to any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon

conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than
TWENTY FIVE (\$25.00) DOLLARS and costs of prosecution, and in de-
fault of payment of such fine and costs to imprisonment for not
more than TEN (10) DAYS.
