

ORDINANCE NO. 3

An Ordinance to open a road wholly within Rush Township,
Schuylkill County.

Whereas, in the judgment of the supervisors they have decided
in the interest of public convenience, to open by ordinance, a section
of road herein described, now therefore

Be it Ordained and Enacted by the Supervisors of Rush Township,
and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same,

Section 1. That in the judgment of the Supervisors, the fol-
lowing described roads situate in Hometown in Rush Township aforesaid be
and the same are opened.

- a. Rymin Road from the intersection of Dennison Street
Southwardly a distance of Six Hundred Fifty (650)
feet to Beechwood Street, being forty (40) feet in
width; and continuing from Beechwood Street four
hundred (400) feet to a circle, being fifty (50)
feet in width from Beechwood Street to circle.
- b. Cumberland Avenue from the intersection of Dennison
Street, Northwardly two hundred seventy-five (275) feet
to Township portion of Cumberland Avenue of the width
of fifty (50) feet.
- c. Ardmore Avenue from the intersection of Lynnwood Street
Southwardly seventeen hundred (1700) feet to Claryan
Street of the width of fifty (50) feet.
- d. Dennison Street from the intersection of Ardmore Avenue
Westwardly a distance of two hundred twenty-five (225)

feet of the width of fifty (50) feet to Cumberland Avenue; and extending from Cumberland Avenue a distance of four hundred seventy-five (475) feet of the width of forty (40) feet to State Highway Route 309.

- e. Locust Street from the intersection of Ardmore Avenue Westwardly a distance of seven hundred (700) feet to Sherwood Street of the width of thirty (30) feet.
- f. Sherwood Street from the intersection of Ardmore Avenue Westwardly a distance of seven hundred eighty (780) feet of the width of fifty (50) feet to Rymon Road.
- g. Elizabeth Street from the intersection of Ardmore Avenue Westwardly a distance of seven hundred eighty (780) feet of the width of forty (40) feet to Rymin Road.
- h. Claryan Street from the intersection of Ardmore Avenue Westwardly a distance of eight hundred (800) feet of the width of fifty (50) feet to Rymin Road.

Section 2. That the Township Solicitor is authorized and directed to file a certified copy of the Ordinance in the Office of the Court of Quarter Sessions together with the names of the owner of property affected and a draft and survey of the road.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
