

O R D I N A N C E 31

An Ordinance laying out, adopting and taking over a certain street or road in the Hometown Section of Rush Township; fixing the length and width and termini thereof and ordaining the same to be a public road.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF RUSH TOWNSHIP, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the provisions of the Second Class Township Code, Article XI, Section 66101 et seq., and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

SECTION 1: The following street or road is hereby laid out, opened, adopted, taken over and ordained as follows:

1. A road in the Hometown Section of Rush Township, being FIFTY (50') feet in width and leading Eastwardly from Ardmore Avenue a distance of FOUR HUNDRED FORTY (440' ±), more or less, ending in a cul-de-sac which has a radius of FIFTY (50') feet. The road shall be known as Lynwood Street.

SECTION 2: The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any of its provisions, or any part of any provision shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this Ordinance would have been adopted if such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid provision had not been included herein.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with any of the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
