

AN ORDINANCE renaming certain streets in the Hometown Section of Rush Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, and providing for the continuing validity of deeds heretofore written.

WHEREAS the Planning Commission of Rush Township have notified the Board of Supervisors that certain streets in the Hometown Section of the Township which are physically unconnected have the same name, and

WHEREAS confusion is apt to exist among the general public due to the multiplicity of names.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED as follows:

1. The following streets are hereby renamed:
  - a. MAPLE STREET in the Marinier Section of Rush Township, a street extending from Legislative Route 185 Northeastwardly ending at a dead end beyond Meadow Avenue be, and the same is hereby renamed MARINIER STREET.
  - b. MAPLE STREET in the Martin Ryan Section of Rush Township, extending from Hunter Street East to Frankford Avenue be, and the same is hereby renamed KENNEDY STREET.
  - c. LINCOLN AVENUE in the Martin Ryan Section of Rush Township extending from Ridge Street East to Tamaqua Street be, and the same is hereby renamed BLACKWELL AVENUE.
  - d. BIRCH STREET in the Martin Ryan Section of Rush Township extending from Ridge Street to Tamaqua Street be, and the same is hereby renamed as EISENHOWER STREET.
2. Nothing contained in this Ordinance shall effect the

validity of any deed heretofore written conveying real estate situate on any of the aforesaid streets.
