

ORDINANCE NO. 35

AN ORDINANCE abandoning a portion of a road in the Hometown Section; laying-out, adopting, and taking over three (3) streets or roads; two (2) in the Tamanend section and one (1) in the Lakeview section of Rush Township; fixing the lengths, widths, and termini thereof and ordinaing the same to be Township Roads.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Rush Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the provisions of the Act of 1947, P.L. 1481, Section 15 &c. (53 PS 66101) as amended, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

SECTION I: The following portion of a street laid out in the Hometown Section of Rush Township, is hereby abandoned:

1. A portion of Walnut Street fronting twenty five (25') feet on Tamaqua or Grant Street and extending of that width westwardly a distance of two hundred ninety (290') feet six (6") inches.

SECTION II: The following streets and roads are hereby laid out, opened, adopted, taken over, and ordained as follows:

1. A road in the Tamanend section of Rush Township leading eastwardly from Township Road No. 860 a distance of six hundred (600±) feet, more or less, said road being fifty (50') feet in width.
2. A road in the Tamanend section of Rush Township leading northwestwardly from Township Road No. 860 a distance of four hundred eighty (480±) feet, more or less, said road being fifty (50') feet in width.

3. A road in the Lakeview section of Rush Township leading ^{WESTWARD} westwardly from Pennsylvania Legislative Route No. 53040 a distance of eight hundred fifty (850[±]) feet, more or less, said road being thirty (30') feet in width.

SECTION III: The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any of it's provisions, or any part of any provision shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this Ordinance would have been adopted if such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid provisions had not been included herein.

SECTION IV: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
