ORDINANCE NO. 39

AN ORDINANCE laying out, adopting, naming a certain road in the Barnesville Section of Rush Township; fixing the length, width, and termini thereof, and ordaining the same to be a Township Road.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Rush Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the provisions of the Act of 1947, known as the Township Code, Section 1101; 53 PS. 66101 as amended, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

SECTION I: The following road is hereby laid out, opened, adopted, ordained and named as follows:

1. A portion of Township Route No. 856, beginning at a point on the North right of way line of Traffic Route 54, said point being the center line of Township Road No. 856 and known as Station 70+25.20; thence along the center line of proposed relocation of Township Route 856 to Station 72+00 and being of equal width of twenty five (25') feet on both sides of the center line; thence beginning at Station 72+00 thirty (30') feet on each side of center line and at 72+50 forty five (45') feet west of the center line and thirty five (35') feet east of the center line to Station 73+06.93; thence at Station 73+06.93 extending fifty five (55') feet on the west and still thirty five (35') feet on the east; thence to Station 73+50 at the above noted distances; thence to Station 73+75 to a distance on the west of forty (40') feet and thirty five (35') feet on the east; thence to Station 74+00 to a distance of twenty five (25') feet on the west and twenty five (25') feet to the east; thence to the south edge of right of way of existing right of way of Township Route 856 and containing one and one-half (1 1/2) Acres.

SECTION II: The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any of its provisions, or any part of any provision shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining por-

tions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this Ordinance would have been adopted if such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid provision had not been included therein.

SECTION III: All Ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
