

ORDINANCE NO. 45

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING TRANSIENT RETAIL  
MERCHANTS TO OBTAIN A LICENSE FROM THE  
SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RUSH AND  
PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

The Board of Supervisors of Rush Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1. Every person, whether principal or agent, entering into, beginning, or desiring to begin, a transient retail business in Rush Township for the sale of any goods, wares, or merchandise, shall obtain a license for the same from the Supervisors of said Township.

Section 2. The fee to be paid for such license shall be Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars for each month or fractional part thereof and shall be collected by the Supervisors before they issue any license under the provisions of this Ordinance. Such license shall be renewed monthly by the Supervisors upon payment of the license fee herein provided.

Section 3. Nothing contained in this Ordinance shall be construed to apply to farmers selling their own produce, or to any sale of goods, wares, or merchandise, donated by the owners thereof, the proceeds whereof are to be applied to any charitable or philanthropic purpose.

Section 4. Any person who shall violate any of the

provisions of this Ordinance by failing to secure the license required hereby, or to renew the said license, as the case may be, shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars and costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment thereof, to imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days.
