

ORDINANCE NO. 5

An Ordinance to open a road wholly within Rush Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the supervisors they have decided in the interest of public convenience, to open by ordinance, a section of road herein described, now therefore

Be it Ordained and Enacted by the Supervisors of Rush Township, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same,

Section 1. That in the judgment of the Supervisors, the following described roads situate in Hometown in Rush Township aforesaid be and the same are opened.

- a. Kahler Avenue from the intersection of said Avenue with State Highway Route No. 45 Northwestwardly and North a distance of one thousand sixty-five (1065) feet to Oak Street, being fifty (50) feet in width.
- b. Oak Street from the intersection of said street with Kahler Avenue Eastwardly a distance of one thousand (1000) feet to the end thereof and the point where said street meets the land of the Estate of Mary A. Miller, Deceased, being fifty (50) feet in width.

Section 2. That the Township Solicitor is authorized and directed to file a certified copy of the Ordinance in the Office of the Court of Quarter Sessions together with the names of the owner of

property affected and a draft and survey of the road.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
