

ORDINANCE NO. 6

An Ordinance to vacate certain portions of a road wholly within Rush Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS, the State Highway Department of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has abandoned certain portions of Route 185 within the Township of Rush and has relocated portions of the said highway, and,

WHEREAS, the abandoned portions of said highway have become Township roads by operation of law, and,

WHEREAS, certain of the said abandoned portions of the highway, now Township roads, are of no use to the traveling public and therefore, the Supervisors in their judgment and upon request of the adjoining land owners, have decided to vacate certain portions of the abandoned highway hereinafter described, NOW THEREFORE,

Be It Ordained and Enacted by the Supervisors of Rush Township, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same,

SECTION 1. That the following described roads situate in Hometown in Rush Township aforesaid, be and the same are vacated.

- (a) The old right-of-way, State Highway Route 185 on the West side of the present State Highway Route between stations #86 and #90, as shown on State Highway map attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- (b) The old right-of-way, State Highway Route 185 on the East side of the present State Highway Route between stations #92 and #95, as shown on said map.

SECTION 2. That the Township Solicitor is authorized and directed to file a certified copy of the Ordinance in the Office of the Court of Quarter Sessions together with a draft and survey of the road.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances
inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
