

ORDINANCE NO. 79

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCES NOS. 34 AND 68 IN REGARD TO THE RECREATION BOARD OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RUSH; PROVIDING FOR APPOINTMENTS AND ORGANIZATION; AND STATING THE AUTHORITY AND RESTRICTIONS ON POWERS OF THE BOARD.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Rush Township:

1. The duly created Recreation Board of the Township of Rush shall hereinafter consist of no less than seven (7) persons to be appointed by the Board of Supervisors for such terms as shall permit no more than two (2) terms to expire in any one (1) calendar year.

2. The Members of the Recreation Board shall be appointed by the Board of Supervisors of Rush Township for terms of five (5) years, in such order that at least one member's term shall expire annually. The aforesaid appointments for a specified term notwithstanding, a Recreation Board Member may stay in office until a successor qualifies or is appointed, or the Board of Supervisors may remove any Member from the Recreation Board at its pleasure.

3. The Members of the Recreation Board shall be residents of the Township and shall serve without pay and vacancies in said Board, occurring otherwise than by expiration of a term, shall be filled by the Board of Supervisors for the unexpired term in the same manner as original appointment.

4. The Recreation Board shall elect its own Chairman and Secretary and any other officers deemed necessary, to serve for a

period of one (1) year.

5. The Recreation Board, at such times as directed by the Board of Supervisors, shall annually submit for approval to the Board of Supervisors a proposed budget for the ensuing year, setting forth all proposed expenditures and programs. The Recreation Board shall not in any manner obligate the Township of Rush for the payment of any municipal funds until the same is properly and legally appropriated by the Board of Supervisors.

6. The Recreation Board shall exercise the authority granted herein over any recreation place acquired hereafter or now existing within the boundaries of the Township, unless otherwise specified by the Board of Supervisors.

7. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. The following Ordinances or parts thereof are specifically repealed:

Ordinance No. 34 enacted August 1, 1969; and

Ordinance No. 68 enacted February 3, 1983.

8. This Ordinance shall become effective on December 16, 1988.
