

ORDINANCE NO. 83

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 59 IN REGARD TO THE CREATION OF AN ENVIRONMENTAL ADVISORY COUNCIL; INCREASING THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS TO SERVE FROM A MAXIMUM OF FIVE (5) TO A MAXIMUM OF SEVEN (7).

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 59 and enacted on October 2, 1980, the Board of Supervisors of Rush Township (hereinafter "Board") created an Environmental Advisory Council; and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance, particularly in Section 2, establish membership of the Council to number either three (3) or five (5) members; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the present Board to increase the number of members of the Council to a maximum of seven (7);

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Rush Township that the duly created Environmental Advisory Council shall hereinafter consist of not less than seven (7) members to be appointed by the Board of Supervisors.

This Ordinance shall become effective on February 1, 1990.
