PUBLIC COMMENT- Mr. Christian 22 Ryan Avenue asked about the paving job on Ryan Avenue, he wanted to know when or about it was going to start. Bill McMullen said at the meeting that right now they are probably looking at the first or second week of May. Roy of 22 Lincoln Street said that the road has not had any work done in the last 24 years that he has lived there and that there are only two houses on the street, his and a neighbor across the street. The slope of the road is no longer there and that when it rains it is about 2 feet of mud. Shawn, Chairman, said that they will have the Road department look into it and possibly put shale and stone to stop the water from flooding the end of the road. Kyle Sherry, Lynwood Street talked about wanting the road on Lynwood being paved. He was told that they will do repairs between May and October with hot patch. Resident, Lori Lewis spoke about the bus parking at St. Jerome's school. She states that the buses idle for more than half an hour and they fumes are terrible. The cars are also backed up on Carmen Street. She was told that the school has all access to township roads. She brought up Marinier, not a priority to pave right now. The stormdrains on Bynosky, she claims there is too much water. Supervisors say that the water goes into the field at the school.
