RESOLUTION NO. 2024-11

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Rush Township desire to have a referendum question put to the voters of the Township to determine whether the voters favor an increase in real estate taxes in order to fund the employment of additional municipal police coverage;


NOW, THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Rush Township that a Referendum question be submitted to the Schuylkill County Board of Elections to be placed on either the 2024 primary election ballot on April 23, 2024 or on the 2024 general election ballot on November 5, 2024 to be phrased as follows:

“Do you favor the imposition of a 4 mill tax increase (the current millage is 5.62) on real property in Rush Township on your Municipal tax billed in March of each year in order to generate revenue to be used to employ additional municipal police coverage in Rush Township?
