
RESOLUTION NO. 2024-16



Rush Township Rules and Regulations for Organic Recycling Facility at  
54 Progress Avenue, Tamaqua, PA 18252 effective September 26, 2024

1. The initial Permit fee shall be \$35.00. The annual renewal of Permit fee shall be \$10.00. The initial Permit is good for the calendar year in which it is issued, and the renewal must be undertaken at the beginning of each calendar year. If Permit card is lost and needs to be replaced, the replacement fee is \$10.00. Permit applications/registration and renewal fees must be paid via check or money order, no cash will be accepted.
2. If any information provided by the applicant on the Permit application/registration form changes, the updated information shall be provided to the Rush Township Secretary in writing.
3. Only Rush Township residents or property owners may apply for a Permit. Only items and materials from the Permit-holder's residence or property may be dropped-off or deposited for recycling.
4. The organic recycling facility is at this time only accepting clean grass clippings, and only up to a maximum of 4 bushels per week per Permit-holder. In the future Rush Township may add brush and tree branches, leaves and vegetation (flowers/plants) and /or other items or materials to the items or materials currently accepted.
5. No plastic bags, metal, trash of any kind, or bamboo may be mingled or included with the clean grass clippings that will be placed into the tub grinder.
6. Rush Township's employees and agents have the right to refuse to dispose of any items or materials.
7. Items and materials may only be dropped off or deposited for recycling during hours of operation of the organic recycling facility, which hours will be posted on the Rush Township website.
8. Rush Township may offer products for sale from the organic recycling facility such as firewood or wood chips. These products may be purchased by a Permit-holder or a non-Permit holder, who shall be responsible to haul any purchased products from the organic recycling facility. The initial cost shall be \$15 for all the fire wood that can be loaded in a vehicle the size of a pick-up truck or smaller, and \$5 per ton for wood chips. Rush Township's obligation to provide these products is based on availability.
