RESOLUTION NO. 2024-20

WHEREAS, Section 35 of the Local Tax Collection Law, 72 P.S. Section 5511.35, provides in relevant part that an elected Tax Collector for a township of the second class with 3,000 or more residents, and Rush Township has a population of 3,417 per the 2020 Census, has compensation fixed by the taxing authority, and shall not exceed 5% of the amount collected; and

WHEREAS, Section 36a of the Local Tax Collection Law, 72 P.S. Section 5511.36a, provides in relevant part that an increase in compensation for the Tax Collector shall be adopted by Resolution and adopted prior to February 15 of the year of the municipal election where the office is on the ballot; and

WHEREAS, the Rush Township Tax Collector currently receives compensation in the amount of 3% of the amount collected;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED as follows:

1. The compensation for the Rush Township Tax Collector is hereby raised from 3% of the amount collected to 3.75% of the amount collected.
2. Per the requirements of the Pennsylvania Constitution, the increase in compensation stated in Paragraph 1 shall be effective at the beginning of the next term of office of the incumbent Tax Collector, or at the beginning of the new term of office for any newly elected or appointed Tax Collector.
3. The Tax Collector shall be provided actual and needful expenditures for printing, postage, books, blanks and forms.
